Following dialogue and lyrics of live theater can be challenging. Increase your enjoyment of Broadway and other shows with these tips.

- Select seating that is close enough to see facial expressions and mouth movement, but far enough back to view the entire stage.
- Become familiar with the show in advance. Read reviews, the script and the lyrics, listen to the music and watch the movie (if available)
- Find out which accommodations are available at the theater at www.theateraccess.nyc
- If theater offers live captions, download Gala Pro app in advance and fully charge your screen device or use theater provided viewing device
- Consider using a theater provided assistive listening device and show up early before the show starts to secure it
- Join <u>Theater Development Fund's Accessibility</u>
