

# Getting the Most Out of Theater



Following dialogue and lyrics of live theater can be challenging. Increase your enjoyment of Broadway and other shows with these tips.

- ✓ Select seating that is close enough to see facial expressions and mouth movement, but far enough back to view the entire stage.
- ✓ Become familiar with the show in advance. Read reviews, the script and the lyrics, listen to the music and watch the movie (if available)
- ✓ Find out which accommodations are available at the theater at [www.theateraccess.nyc](http://www.theateraccess.nyc)
- ✓ If theater offers live captions, download Gala Pro app in advance and fully charge your screen device or use theater provided viewing device
- ✓ Consider using a theater provided assistive listening device and show up early before the show starts to secure it
- ✓ Join [Theater Development Fund's Accessibility Programs](#) for special open caption and ASL interpreted performances or check out [HandsOn](#) for ASL Interpreted shows
