## Here for You and Your Child with Hearing Loss

The Pediatric Center at the Center for Hearing and Communication (CHC) is here to support and guide you every step of the way in your child's journey to hearing.

We have an 80-year track record of success in helping 'CHC kids' develop the listening, speech and language skills needed to thrive in main-stream schools.

Our caring speech-language pathologists and teachers of the deaf and hard of hearing work in collaboration with other CHC and outside pediatric specialists to ensure that services are tailored to the specific needs and goals of the child and family.

### A Family-Centered Approach

Parents are encouraged to participate in weekly therapy sessions and to learn strategies to implement at home so they become the primary facilitators of their child's language growth.

Families benefit from peer-to-peer connection through weekend social programming, evening parent workshops and other events that bring together the CHC community.

At CHC your child will get more than the technical skills of listening and speaking with hearing loss. Our program emphasizes interpersonal skills, academic needs and emotional health, ensuring their comprehensive needs are met.

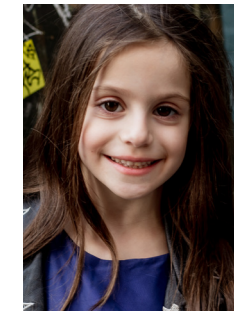
